

FRONTIER Drum and Bugle Corps 2009 DUES STRUCTURE

\$695 for each marching member.

\$350 per additional family member (must live in the same household).

Open House will have a charge of \$25 (this will include a free T shirt).

Payments made in the 2008 calendar year do not qualify towards dues (exploratory period) unless balance is paid early.

All payments made in 2009 will count towards your dues.

All rehearsals will have a flat charge of \$50 until dues are paid in full.

Early payment will receive credit for all 08 rehearsals. Payment must be made in full by 1st May.

Dues do not include transportation to any shows. Road transportation will be organized by the corps however will be charged for separately (guide line \$100 to \$150 per trip subject to gas prices).

If someone introduces a new full paying member into the corps then a \$100 credit will be awarded toward their dues payment (once Frontier has received the new member's 4th rehearsal payment).

Members to pay for pants, gloves, plumes and shoes.

Every DCI/DCA marching member pays.

\$75 uniform surcharge for each new member.

Food and water at any point in the season is not covered within dues.

Fundraising Credits (excludes management team).

An organizer of an activity will receive a \$100 credit for every \$500 raised (they will not qualify for a contribution credit as described below).

Fundraising events pre the 1st March - A participant of a fundraising event will receive a credit equal to 50% of their contribution directly towards their dues.

Fundraising events pre the 1st August - A participant of a fundraising event will receive a credit equal to 25% of their contribution directly towards their dues.
